

**TAY VALLEY TOWNSHIP PASSED ATV BY-LAW 11/027  
DATED 14 JUNE 2011**

**ATV'S NOW PERMITTED ON TOWNSHIP ROADS**

**ATV's**

ATV's may now be driven on TOWNSHIP roads. This does NOT include:

- Provincial Highway #7
- any County roads  
(#'s 6,7,12,14,19,21 or 36)
- any Private roads.

ATV's are to be driven single-file on the shoulder or extreme right side of the road and must yield to other users of the road.

**The maximum speed limit on ANY road is  
20 km/hr.**

The use of ATV's is strictly regulated in Ontario by the Highway Traffic Act and the Off-Road Vehicles Act. Accordingly, to drive on a road you must:

- hold a G2 drivers license
- have plates, registration and insurance
- have a properly maintained vehicle
- wear a helmet.

Any person who contravenes the Highway Traffic Act or By-law 11-027 is guilty of an offence and subject to fines of \$110 or more. **These rules will be enforced by the OPP.**
