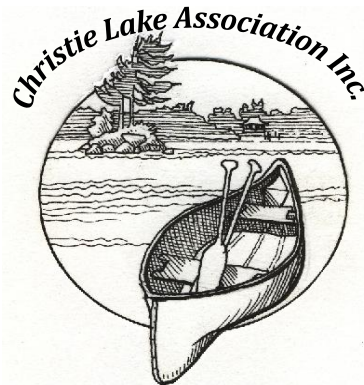

Transport Canada Recommends

- attach engine shut-off line to wrist driving a PWC
- wear a properly fitted PDF or lifejacket
- take an accredited safe boating course
- check weather and water conditions
- check all equipment before departing

Invasive Species - What You Can Do

- do not run through aquatic plants
- on exiting the lake drain all water from boat
- remove all visible plant, fish, animal fragments and mud
- clean all parts that came in contact with the water
- clean all equipment such as anchors, buckets, etcetera
